Sojourn – Paintings by Claus Brunsmann

"In the beginning I tried to measure the room. I drew a grid on the canvas with coal. It looked like a prison. I had three colors: black, white and blue. Those colors I put inside the grid. That's how it started."

In *Sojourn*, Claus Brunsmann presents his most recent work — multilayered abstract oil paintings, that offer the viewer multiple avenues for understanding and visual experience. *Sojourn* characterizes the artist's continuing experimentation with color and spatial tension, oscillating between the figurative and the abstract, to create an openended painting whose aim is not the finished work, but the evocation of possibilities, and the act of seeing.
